1 INTRODUCTION

- 1.1 This AWN introduces a change in BCAA documentation relating to the deregistration process.

2 BACKGROUND

- 2.1 Further to a 2020 proposal ICAO has amended Annex 7 to amendment 7 and introduced the certificate of deregistration. The format and content of this certificate are as specified in Annex 7.
- 2.2 BCAA previously issued letters of deregistration and will now implement the ICAO recommendation for certificates of deregistration conforming to the ICAO Annex 7 standard, with effect from 01 June 2023.

3 INSTRUCTIONS

- 3.1 The introduction of certificates of deregistration requires no change for owners/applicants in the process of deregistration from the Bermuda aircraft register.
- 3.2 From 01 June 2023 BCAA will provide electronically signed, digital certificates of deregistration, upon satisfactory completion of the deregistration process.
- 3.3 Certificates of deregistration will be provided to the owner and when requested, to the aviation authority of the importing state.
